2. Medication Policy for Use of Inhalers

- 1. The physician must complete the prescription medication form.
- 2. Parents must sign a form indicating their permission for their child to self-administer the inhaler if the student is n grades 7-12.
- 3. The inhaler must b kept inside the labeled prescription box. Any non-labeled inhalers or inhalers without a labeled box will not be permitted in school.
- 4. The label from the pharmacy must include the student's name, physician's name, and name of the medication, and instructions for use.
- 5. Students in grades K-6 must keep inhalers in the health room. Students in grades 7-12 may carry inhalers providing they can administer the inhaler independently. A physician's order must state the student can carry the inhaler.
- 6. No inhaler is to be shared with any other person. Inhalers must be used responsibly. The school reserves the right to confiscate the inhaler and remove the privileges to carry the medication if a child abuses or ignores the school policy. The parent will be notified immediately.
